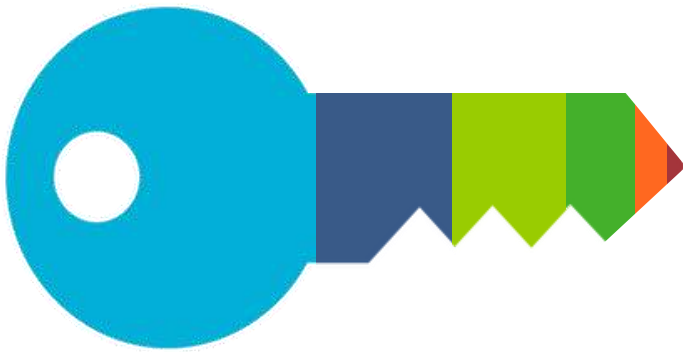

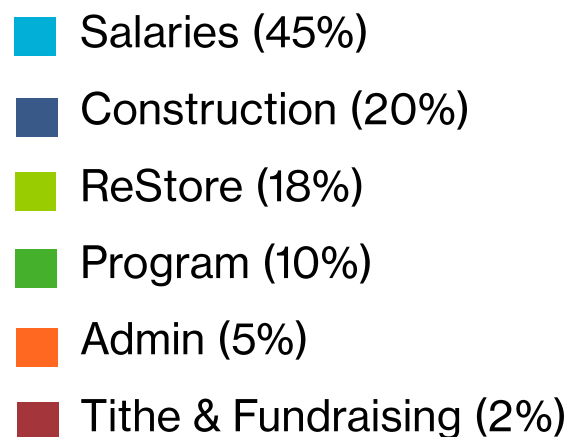


Over 5% revenue increase

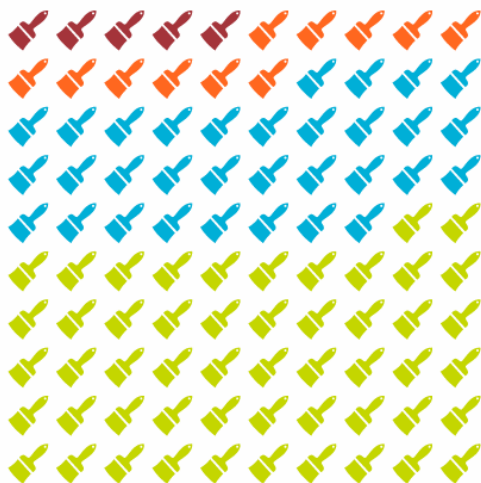
